### Let your family know.

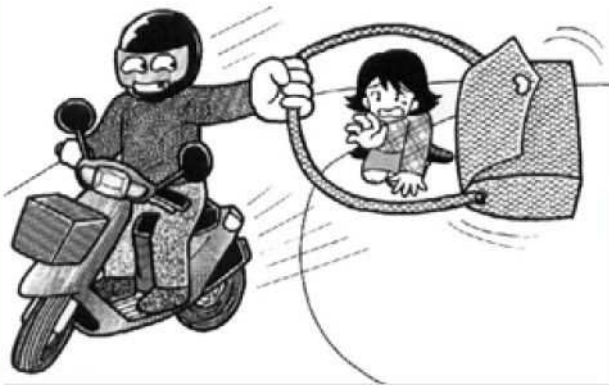
Tell your family who you are going to play with, where you are going and the time you finish playing.

## Precautions against snatch theft

### Carry your bag on the inside.

Carry your bag on the inside (opposite the open road).



### Put a cover over the basket.

Put a cover over the front basket properly



### Keep your valuables with you.



Keep your valuables with you when you carry your bag across your shoulder.

### Beware of your surroundings.



Beware of suspicious people who come up behind you.

## Tips on preventing your bicycle from theft

Be sure to use two locks to protect your bicycle!!

More than half of the bicycles are stolen because they are unlocked.

Thieves can come in from anywhere. Be sure to lock your house even when you are at home.

In Saitama Prefecture, there have been many cases of molestation which target a woman walking alone on the way home in the middle of the night.

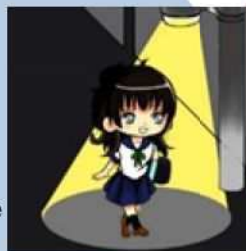


## Precautions against molesters



### Use well-lit streets.

It is dangerous to walk in narrow and deserted streets. Walk in well-lit streets and where there are many people.



### Carry a security alarm.

Carry a security alarm so that you can use it when necessary.



### walking while doing something else is dangerous!!

Never "walk while listening to music or using a cell phone" because it may cause you not to be able to notice suspicious people around you.
